Whitetail Deer Day Hunts

Glasscock County
 South of Big Spring, Texas
 30,000 acres available

Borden County
 North of Big Spring, Texas along the Colorado River
 Currently 10,000 acres unleased for deer

Day Hunts

Glasscock County
 \$400/person/day (2 person minimum)
 (Up to 5 days; applies toward Shot Buck Fee)
 + \$2000/buck shot upto 134 7/8 B&C score
 +150/point starting at 135 & up B&C score

Includes:
 Stands & feeders

Does NOT include:
 Transportation to/from stand
 Meals
 Lodging

\$500/day if (1) person only or combination;
 deer, quail, sandhill crane, dove & duck
 in season, prairie dog and/or predators,
 primarily coyote.
 Permit needed for Sandhill Crane

Borden County
 \$300/person/day (2 person minimum)
 Up to 5 days
 Applies toward \$1500 Shot Buck Fee
 Add \$100 per B&C score starting with 130
 No doe may be shot
 Mature bucks ONLY

Does NOT include:
 Stands or feeders furnished
 Transportation to/from stand
 Meals
 Lodging

\$1500 per buck Trophy Fee if under 130 B&C score
 + \$100 per point or score starting at 130 B&C

\$400/day for 1 person alone or multi species
 Or combination hunts (quail, deer, duck,
 turkey [1 gobbler/person], dove [if in season],
 fereal hogs, antelope [by State permit only
 and if available]
